SHELBY, NC – **Debi Metcalfe**, founder of **Stolen Horse International, Inc. (SHI)**, announces the production of SHI's biggest fundraising project ever – **SHI's 2006 Calendar** dedicated to stolen horses. The calendar is expected to be available in time for early Christmas shopping at the end of November. The cost will be minimal, and all proceeds will be used to fund SHI's ongoing quest to promote theft education and awareness, as well as the growing administrative costs of operating SHI.

Stolen Horse International, a nonprofit entity, is the first, and continues to be the only, such organization that offers FREE services to theft victims, operating solely on donations. Anyone who knows Debi, knows of her dedication and incredible efforts to locate people's stolen horses since her family's horse, Idaho, was stolen in 1997 and recovered 51 weeks later.

When speaking of the upcoming project, Debi states, "I am thrilled that this project is finally coming to fruition. It has been something that I have wanted to do for several years as I think it's a great way to publicize dozens of horse that have yet to be recovered. The calendar is being created by a SHI volunteer, and will be printed with monies raised from ad sales. I really appreciate this volunteer's help, and I believe the calendar will be a great success.

"Limited advertising space will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis," Debi continues, "and I think our supporters will quickly realize the value to their business when they discover the cost is nominal compared to the benefits received. Since we are focusing this first calendar on stolen horses, we will have space available to individuals who wish to promote the recovery of a horse they are missing, usually from a bad sale situation or one they would like to find and buy back."
